The Property Valuation Services Corporation (PVSC) is a not-for-profit organization responsible for assessing all property in Nova Scotia as mandated under the Nova Scotia Assessment Act.

Pictometry Canada along with parent company Pictometry International is the largest Ariel imaging company in North America providing “Visual Intelligence” via their orthogonal and oblique imagery along with a wide variety of solutions for the Assessment, Government, Public Safety and Infrastructure sectors.

Since 2010 the Property Valuation Services Corporation (PVSC), funded by the Nova Scotia municipalities has been collecting and utilizing Pictometry oblique imagery to provide the annual assessment roll to 54 municipalities which includes the production of approximately 600,000 assessment notices to property owners and overall administration of the property assessment appeal process.

This workshop is intended to educate and share with you the applications, tools and imagery being used by PVSC. We will be providing instructions on how to access the applications and imagery, the basics of navigation along with searching and analysis capabilities using the Pictometry Connect platform that includes Pictometry Online, Pictometry Explorer, Pictometry ArcMAP extension and Pictometry Mobile extensions.
